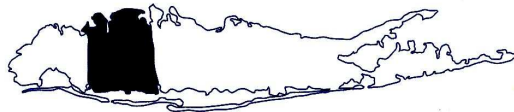

NASSAU COUNSELORS' ASSOCIATION JOSEPH BRUZZESE HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS FOR THE YEAR 2010

To: NASSAU COUNTY HIGH SCHOOL GUIDANCE DIRECTORS/CHAIRPERSONS

The Nassau Counselors' Association will be awarding several scholarships to students graduating in June 2010 from public or private high schools in Nassau County.

The organization wishes to honor seniors who have demonstrated exceptional concern for people. Eligible students must show a commitment to helping others, individually or in a group setting. Financial status and academic achievement are not factors in the selection of candidates. The student must meet the following criteria:

1. Attend a high school in Nassau County
2. Be a June 2010 graduate
3. Plan to pursue further education after high school graduation.
4. Show evidence of concern for others through leadership or participation in an activity that is devoted to helping people.

We are asking that each school do the following:

1. Select **ONE CANDIDATE** from the senior class who meets the criteria outlined above. **NOTE: The person nominating the candidate must be a current member of the Nassau Counselors' Association who was also a member last year (with the exception of new counselors who need only to be a current member). That person does not necessarily have to be the nominating counselor.**
2. Have the candidate complete the attached application and return it to the counselor.
3. Attach **one** letter of recommendation from the counselor, activity sponsor, or another individual who can endorse the student's involvement in the activity.
4. Since academic achievement is not a factor, **transcripts are NOT to be included.**
5. Applications must be submitted/postmarked by **Wednesday, March 24th** (late applications will **not be accepted**) to:

In May, a committee interview is **required**. (Finalists will be contacted to schedule an interview.)
